If I would like to do something different at Carols by Candlelight, I can get my face painted.

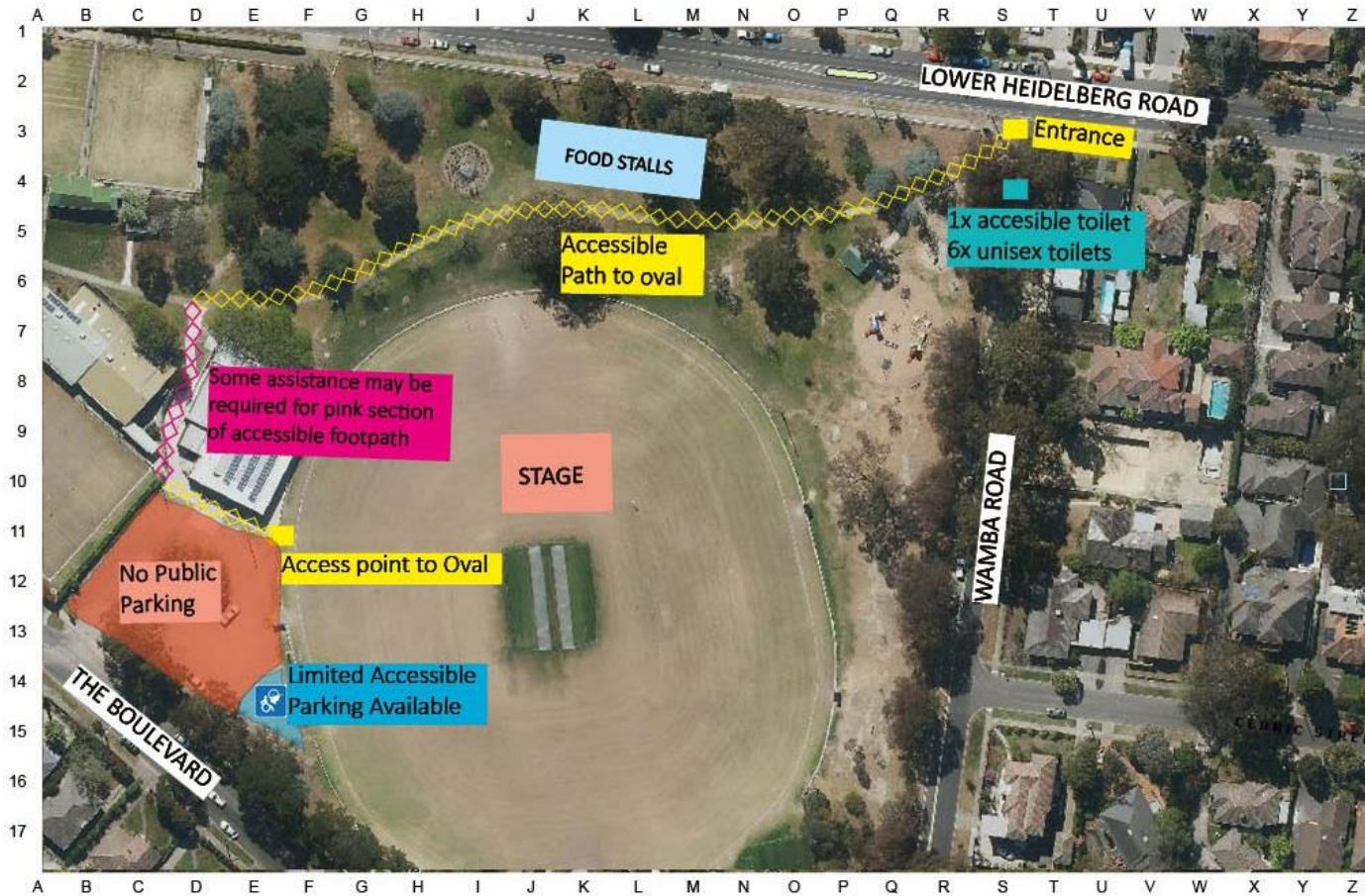


There will be a lot of people at Ivanhoe Park to see Carols by Candlelight. I need to stay close to my family / carer.
