### **EJ Andrews renewal**

Work has begun on improvements at EJ Andrews Reserve in Briar Hill, including rehabilitation of an area that has been used by the Level Crossing Removal Project (LXRP) as a lay-down area during construction of the rail duplication.

The works are jointly funded by Council and LXRP and include wheelchair accessible playground equipment, seating, fencing, tree planting and nature play areas.

Work will continue through spring and we expect to be finished by the end of the year, in time for summer family fun.
